Final Paper Instructions

Write and submit a paper of 6-8 pages (not including the title page and references page) in which you clearly:

- 1. Propose and explain a solution for one current or future social problem related to globalization addressed in this course.
- 2. Analyze and evaluate how one local institution (a community, group, or organization focused more on a particular region than globally) is already involved in your proposed solution to a global social problem.
 - How is its involvement effective?
 - How is it falling short? In other words, what more could it do to effectively implement your solution?

Be sure to answer these questions in your own words, not the words of the institution itself!

- 3. In the conclusion, describe, in detail, how you could help the local institution you evaluated effectively enact your proposed solution(s), at both the local and global levels.
- 4. Also, in the conclusion, reflect on what you expect to learn from effectively enacting your proposed solution(s) at both the local and global levels.
- 5. Draw from and cite at least six different sources. You may use one or more sources from this course: the reader (1 source), a map (1 source), the text or images from a website (1 source), or a video clip (1 source). (You may cite more than one map, website, or video clip and have each count as a different source). However, you are not required to cite any sources from the course.

You are also welcome to cite sources not assigned for this course, but are not required to do so. Just be sure to cite at least six different sources in your paper and on a "References" page.
